**Multicultural Learning Center's Scholarship Fund**

The **Purpose** of the **MLC Scholarship Fund** is to encourage MLC graduates to pursue a college education by providing financial assistance for their first year of college.

**Eligibility Requirements:** Students who graduate from 8<sup>th</sup> grade at MLC having completed a full dual language curriculum with a minimum of 5 years at MLC are eligible. Students must maintain proficiency in both English and Spanish and be accepted to college in order to apply.

Annual **awards** will begin in 2013 with up to:

- One **\$10,000** award for a candidate accepted to a 4-year university
- Six **\$500** awards for candidates accepted to college

**Competition:** Students will submit an application describing their career goals and the impact of being multilingual on their academic and social development and future plans

**Fund History and Growth:** The MLC Scholarship fund was established in 2002 in honor of Alan Bornstein, the husband and father of MLC's founders, Toby Bornstein and Gayle Nadler. Donations are now being solicited on an annual basis to increase the fund and make investments that will cause the fund to grow. The goal is to raise \$100,000 by 2013 when the first award(s) will be made. A review board will be formed to monitor the fund growth and establish procedures for the awarding of scholarships.

Tax deductible donations are encouraged in honor of family members and family events such as births, birthdays, communions, anniversaries, graduations, memorials, etc. Employers will be encouraged to make matching donations.
